

BYLAW NO. 17/02

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE BURNING OF WASTE IN THE TOWN OF CENTRAL BUTTE.

* * * * *

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CENTRAL BUTTE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The use of burning barrels, incinerators, or any other receptacle for the use of burning waste within the town of Central Butte is strictly prohibited.**
- 2. Approval from the council of the Town of Central Butte shall be required prior to causing an open fire for the purposes outlined as follows:**
 - a) a bonfire at celebrations involving the general public.**
 - b) a fire for the purpose of burning brush from land being cleared for cultivation purposes or a roadway or other right of way; and**
 - c) a fire authorized or required by federal, provincial or municipal law for the purpose of weed control, or prevention of fire hazards, the prevention of ground water or soil contamination, or the training of persons for firefighting.**
- 3. A persons who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and upon conviction, shall be liable to the penalty provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Central Butte.**
- 4. Bylaw No. 7/90 shall hereby be repealed.**
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passage thereof.**
