

BYLAW NUMBER 2016-04

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF FIRE BANS

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CENTRAL BUTTE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Administrator of the Town of Central Butte may at their discretion or at the advice of any member of Council, the Central Butte Volunteer Fire Dept. Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief issue, amend or cancel a fire ban for the Town of Central Butte.
2. Any ban issued pursuant to this bylaw includes all outdoor fires and fireworks but does not include propane barbeques.
3. Any person found to be in contravention of any part of this bylaw is subject to a fine of not more than \$1000.00.
4. Any person occupying a spot in any of the Central Butte Campgrounds found to be in contravention of this bylaw is subject to a fine of not more than \$1000.00 and may be evicted from the campground and be prohibited from returning for up to three years.
5. The Administrator of the Town of Central Butte, upon issuing a fire ban pursuant to this bylaw will as soon as practicable communicate the issuing of the fire ban in a manor they deem appropriate.
