

Bylaw No. 60/12

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CENTRAL BUTTE TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

As per section 38(3) of *The Municipalities Act*, the Council of the Town of Central Butte, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Every person who contravenes any provision of any Bylaw of the Town of Central Butte is guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction:
 - a) To the penalty specified in the bylaw or in another bylaw providing for a penalty with respect to the contravention of that bylaw; or
 - b) If no penalty is provided for by the bylaw:
 - i) \$2,000 in the case of an individual; or
 - ii) \$5,000 in the case of a corporation.
3. Bylaw No. 4/88 is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading thereof.
